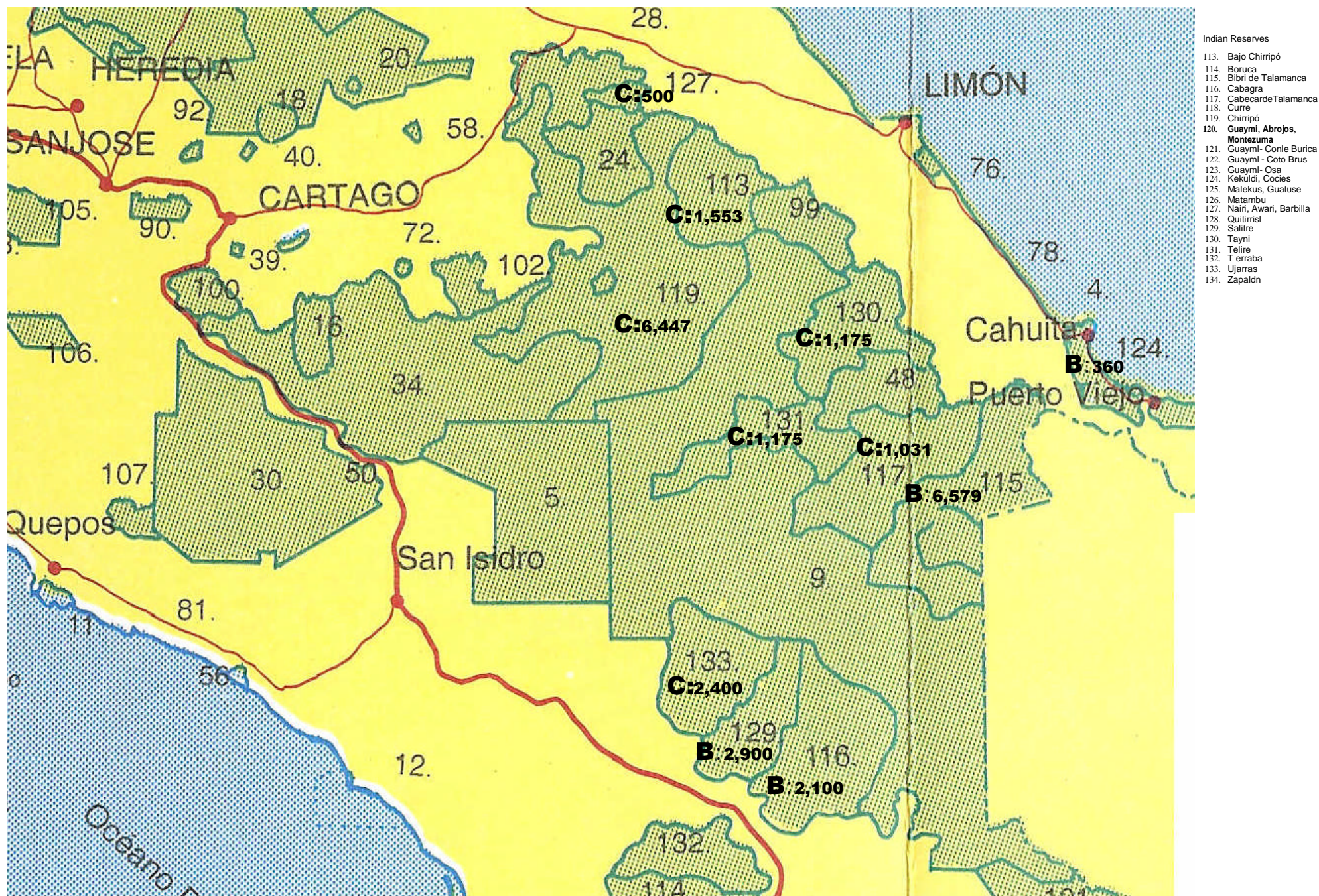


Map of eastern Costa Rica with population on Cabécar and Bribrí reserves indicated.
